We will be finishing on **Friday 26th October 2012** & we will be returning on **Monday 5th November 2012**. Our sessions are linked with the opening hours of Hylands School only.

We would like to welcome all new parents and children to our setting & look forward in working in partnership with you & your child through-out their session with us.

Planning! – We plan through the children’s interest and activity ideas every term. This works by the staff sitting down at the end of each term asking what theme they would like to do and then write down activity ideas. An activity is taking place every week where the children have a choice to sit down with a staff member and carry the activity out. We are also introducing the children to evaluate their own planning at the end of each week.
