Lunches We discourage children to share and swap their food with one another. This is to protect children with food allergies. For children who drink milk, we will provide fresh, milk and water throughout the session. If the children wish to bring in a drink for the session please ensure this is only water. **We Do Not** have the facilities to store or refrigerate food. We therefore ask that you provide an ice pack in your child's lunch bag or box. Please ensure your child's lunch bag or box is clearly labeled with his or her name. **Please do not put treats like sweets, nuts, fizzy-drinks, chocolate, peanut or fruit strings in your child's packed lunch.** Our setting reserves the right to not allow any such items to be consumed at our snack break. Even if your child does not suffer from a food related allergy, we kindly ask you to avoid putting items in your child's lunch that may cause a problem for other children in the setting. Please speak to a member of staff if you have any concerns or allergy updates. Please refrain from putting too many sweet items in their lunch box

Notice- For all funded children a 'Parental Declaration' will have to be completed for the end of June 2018 in-line with the Code of Practice for early years funding for 2, 3 & 4 year old children. **These forms are ready for you to complete during May and June, you will need to fill this in to secure your child's place. Please see Teresa or Jayne**

Parking- Please beware this is very important issue!

- If you do need to park outside the school to drop off or collect your child from our setting, please be courteous to those who live nearby. Please do not block resident's driveways or Double Park in any of the neighbouring streets. This is a serious concern with all residents within the area and we all need to respect others who live nearby. Read, Write Inc

As you are aware all school aged children are taught daily 'Read, Write Inc' By the end of this term all children would have completed **29 Sounds** and **15 Tricky Words**.

I will include in your child's leaving pack a copy of all of the sounds and tricky words they have been learning all year. It would be helpful if you could continue with teaching your children these over the summer before they begin reception.

The tricky words need to be learned by sight and are called 'red words', these cannot be Blended.

With sounds it's helpful for your child to be able to identify each sound by sight and independently say each sound. The Rhyme for each sound encourages the correct writing information.

Thank you for all your support throughout the year in helping your children at home with phonics and for your encouragement.

Early Years Pupil Premium: Pre-school support funding

Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is additional funding for early years pre-school settings to improve the education they provide for disadvantaged 3- and 4 year-olds including, but not restricted to, those adopted from care. The funding goes directly to registered early years providers (including pre-schools, nurseries and child minders) that offer children the free early education entitlement. This extra funding will be spent to Close of gap in attainment with training and resources to suit the requirements of the setting.

Visit the registration page on Gov.UK website

Complete the registration process. If you're eligible, you'll receive a code

Take your code to your childcare provider or local council (if it's council-provided childcare), along with your National Insurance number and your child's date of birth.

Your childcare provider or council will check the code is authentic and allocate your child a free childcare place, if one is available. Existing parents will need to validated their code to continue to be entitled for the 30hrs
