Paint brushes (optional)

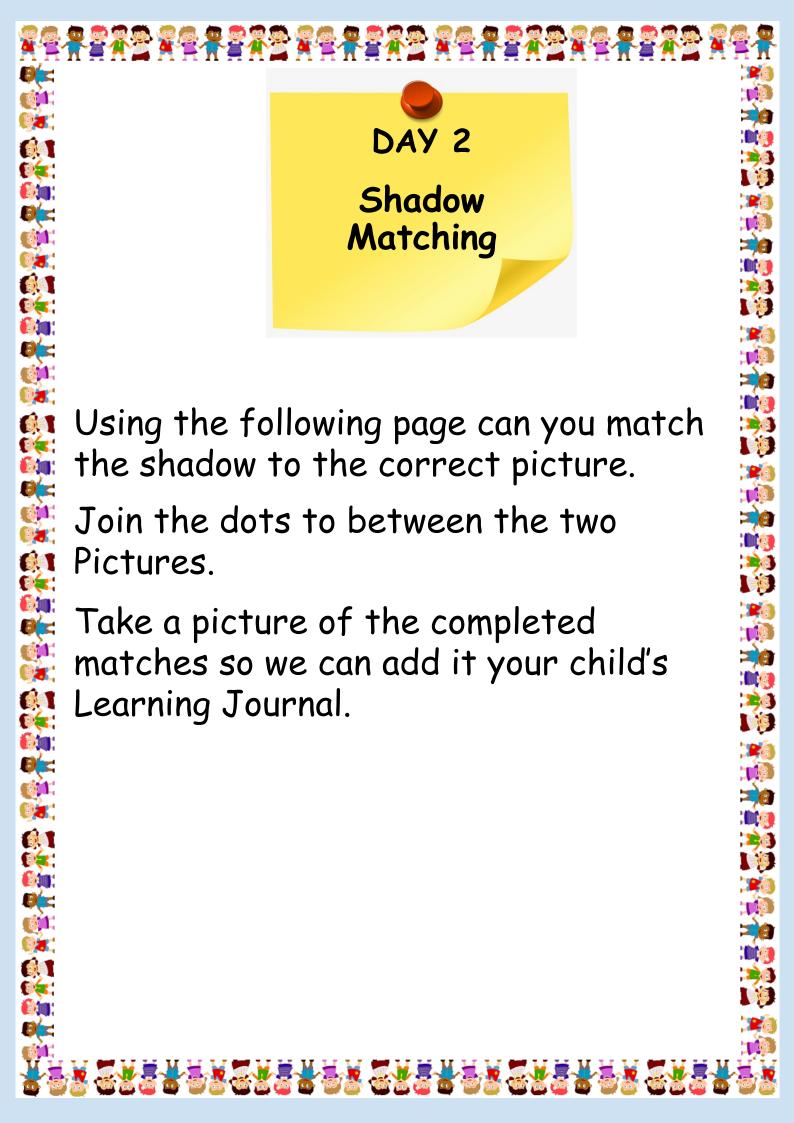
How you do it:

That's it...

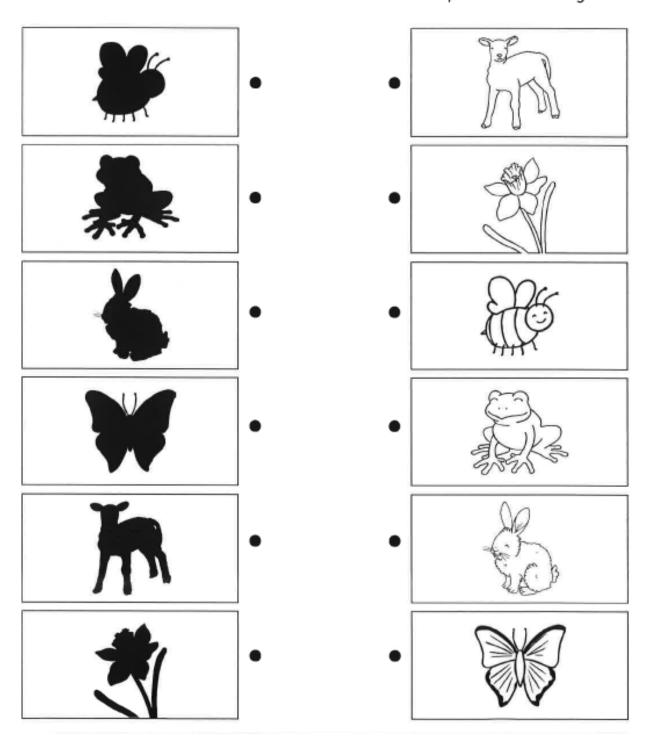

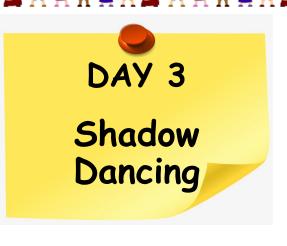
Your child can paint on the windows or a board, it's messy but it will wash straight off

Something to play music on, a torch and a dark area (Make sure there are no objects to fall or knock over).

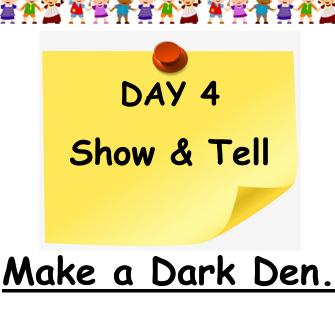
What next:

What to do: Use whatever you can, boxes, clothes horse, chairs and a sheet or blanket and make a den.

Card, a pencil, sticky tape, a thin stick and scissors.

What to do:

- 1. Draw your favourite character/person or animal onto some card.
- 2. Cut the shape out and use the tape to attach it to the stick.
- When your ready take it your dark den or dark room, use your torch and see the shadows they make on the wall.
